

UNOFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE BUFFALO COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
July 2, 2013

Chairman Ronald Petersen called the meeting to order with Commissioners Lloyd Lutter and Donita Loudner present; none absent. Lutter moved to accept the agenda as amended, seconded by Loudner. Lutter moved to approve the Minutes of the previous meeting, seconded by Loudner. Motions carried with Lutter and Loudner voting aye.

Highway Department activities were discussed.

Lutter moved to accept the fuel quote from Darrell's Oil, Inc. for Ethanol gas @ \$3.20.4 per gal. and Diesel #2 dyed @ \$3.29.7 per gal., seconded by Loudner, to be delivered to the Buffalo County fuel tanks during the month of July 2013. Vote: Lutter-Aye; Loudner-Aye. Motion carried.

Everyone is advised to control the noxious weeds. The Weed Supervisor has sent out letters urging compliance.

Lutter moved to approve a one-day liquor license for Saturday, July 6, 2013, at Gann Valley for the Abernathy American Legion Post, seconded by Loudner. Vote: Lutter-Aye; Loudner-Aye. Motion carried.

Sheriff Wayne Willman discussed contracting with Jerauld County for deputy sheriff services. The issue was tabled until the next regular meeting. An interim deputy service was okayed for emergency calls only.

The Commission Board agreed to not opt out of the tax levy limit for 2014.

Hospital Notices were reviewed.

Hospital Requests for Payment #1-13 and #2-13 were received from Sanford Health on behalf of the same individual. Lutter moved to deny payment of claims due to lack of paperwork, non receipt of poor relief application and possibility of not being payer of last resort, seconded by Loudner. Vote: Lutter-Aye; Loudner-Aye. Motion carried.

Lutter moved to approve an Application for Poor Relief Assistance for Claim #3-13 to St. Mary's Healthcare Center in the amount of \$2127.50, seconded by Loudner. Vote: Lutter-Aye; Loudner-Aye. Motion carried.
